Eligible organizations include:

- Organizations based outside of Boone County, if grant money will fund a program that directly effects women in Boone County and is implemented in Boone County.

Submit (1) original and (1) copy of the grant application with the following attachments:

- Board of Directors list
- IRS determination letter
- Most recent annual report or publication
- Organization's budget for the current fiscal year

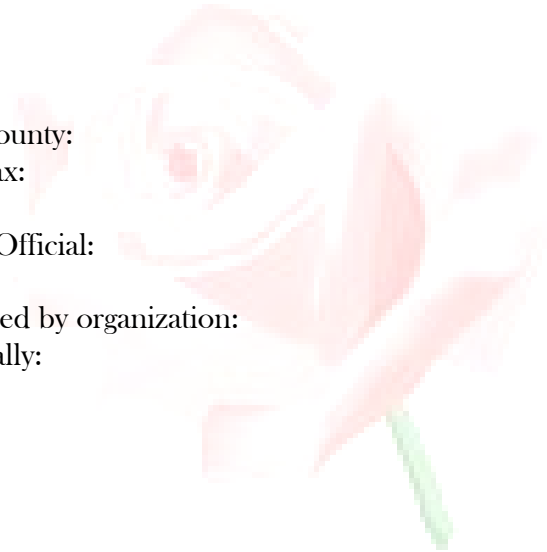
