With the recent escalation of the cancellation and closure activity due to the Coronavirus, COVID-19, it is warranted that the Community Foundation of Boone County (CFBC), state our position and action plans for dealing with this matter.

REVISED MARCH 12, 2020:

- Effective March 13, 2020, the CFBC office located at 102 N. Lebanon Street, Suite 200, will be closed through April 6, 2020. Staff will still be available via email and phone.
- Indiana Code 16-20-1-24 gives the County Board of Health the authority to order schools and churches closed and forbid public gatherings when considered necessary to prevent and stop epidemics.
- The CFBC will monitor and comply with all directives and recommendations from the Boone County Health Department, Indiana State Health Department and Center for Disease control.
- Should any city or school district in Boone County take closure actions with regards to private or public facilities, CFBC employees living in those areas will be allowed to work from home. CFBC by-laws with regards to attendance of board and committee meetings will be suspended and until the closure activity ceases. Any CFBC events in the closed areas will be moved to a date after the closure activity ceases.
